



Clothing Donation Guideline

To ensure the health, safety, and quality of items, the program adheres to strict donation acceptance criteria:

- **Acceptable Items:**
 - Clean, freshly laundered, and odor-free.
 - In good condition (no rips, tears, stains, or excessive wear).
 - Seasonally appropriate (e.g., winter coats in colder months, lighter clothing in warmer months).
 - Include everyday wear and practical items (shirts, pants, jackets, footwear).
 - Include professional attire for veterans seeking employment.
 - New and unopened undergarments, socks, and other personal items (for hygiene and safety).
- **Unacceptable Items:**
 - Visibly dirty, moldy, or stained clothing.
 - Items infested with or exposed to pests (e.g., bedbugs).
 - Extremely outdated or costume-like attire (e.g., formal prom dresses, Halloween costumes, excessively flashy or impractical outfits).
 - Torn, damaged, or excessively worn items (e.g., shirts with large holes, shoes with broken soles).
